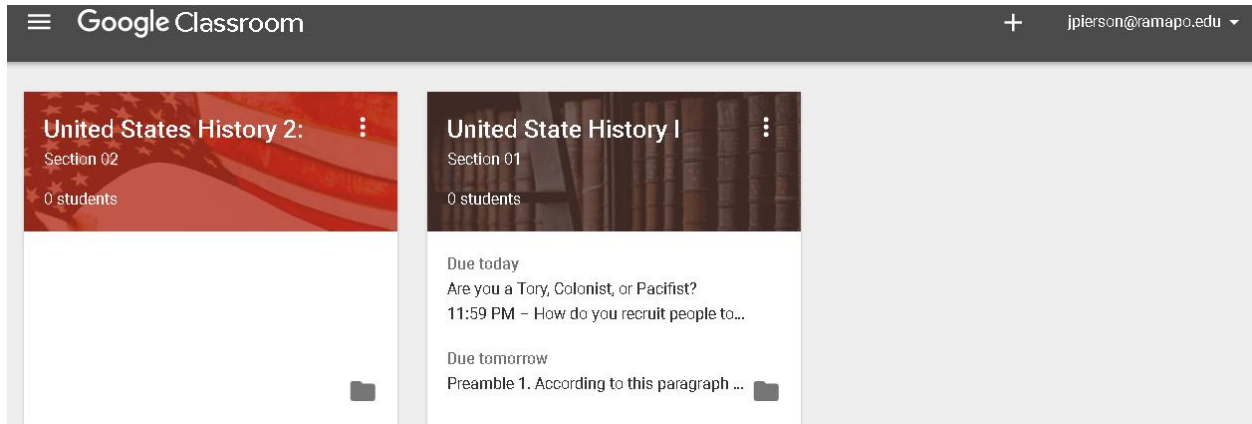

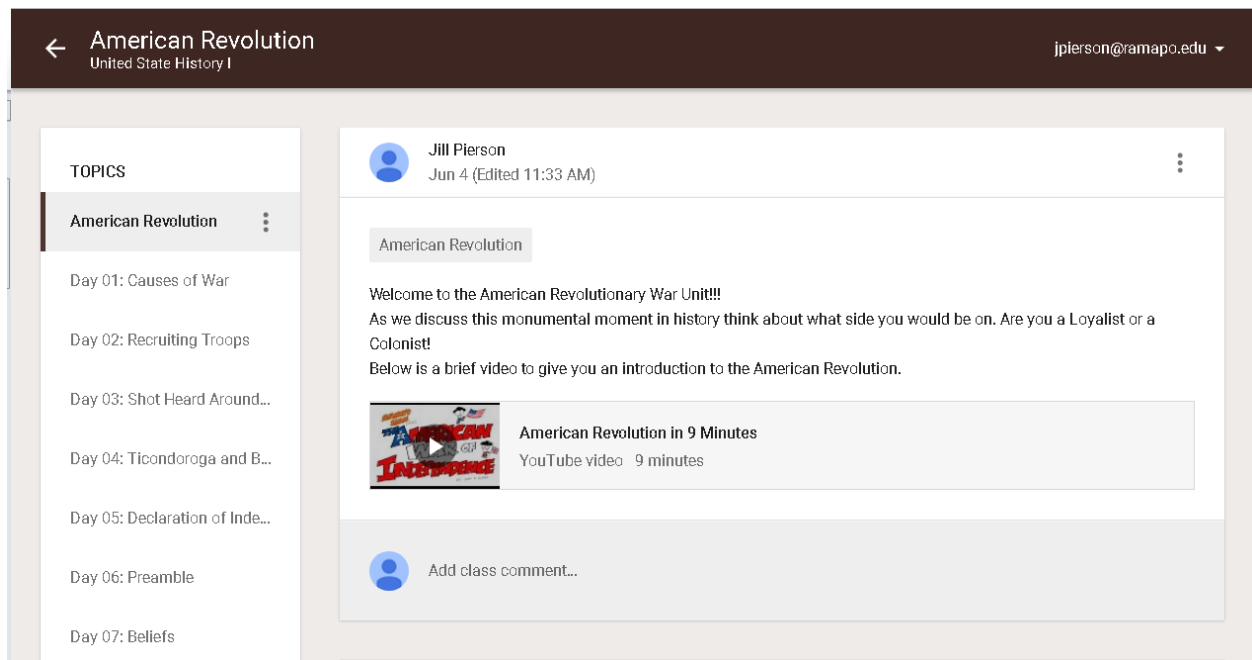
Google Classroom Opening Page
